## Martha's Rules: Preparation is Key!

### **Public Meeting Law**

- Quorum: 11 members (not including OHA staff) are required to reach quorum. Please RSVP meetings!
- Voting: must be public, include voter's names, and voter's decision must be recorded (by OHA).
- Public Attendance and Comment: Attendance is a right but public comment is not. OHA has the authority to include public comment and reasonably restrict (e.g., a time limit) comment.
- Methods of Notice: general notice to the public at large and to provide actual notice to specifically interested persons.
