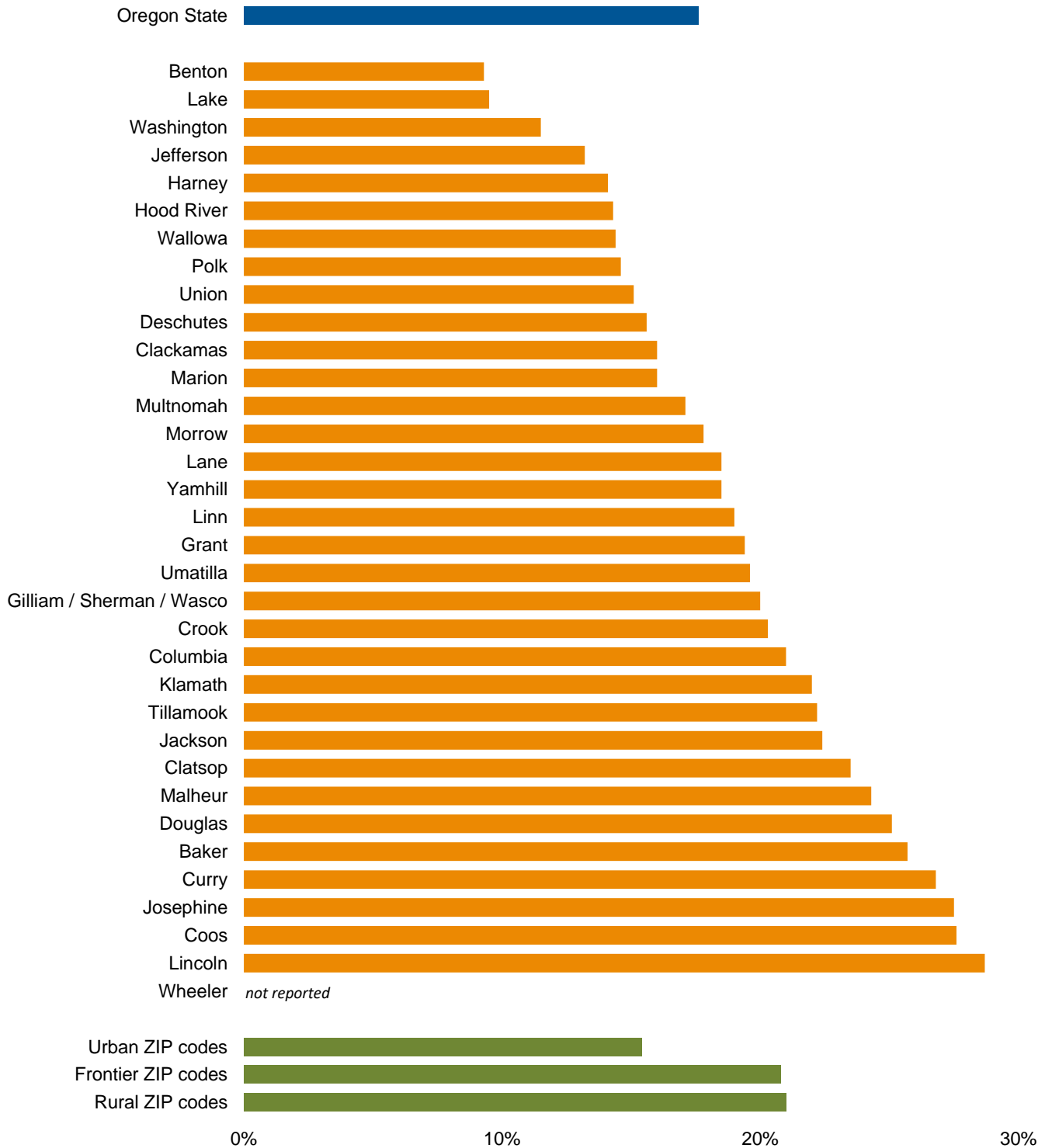


Adults who smoke cigarettes by county, Oregon, 2014–2017
