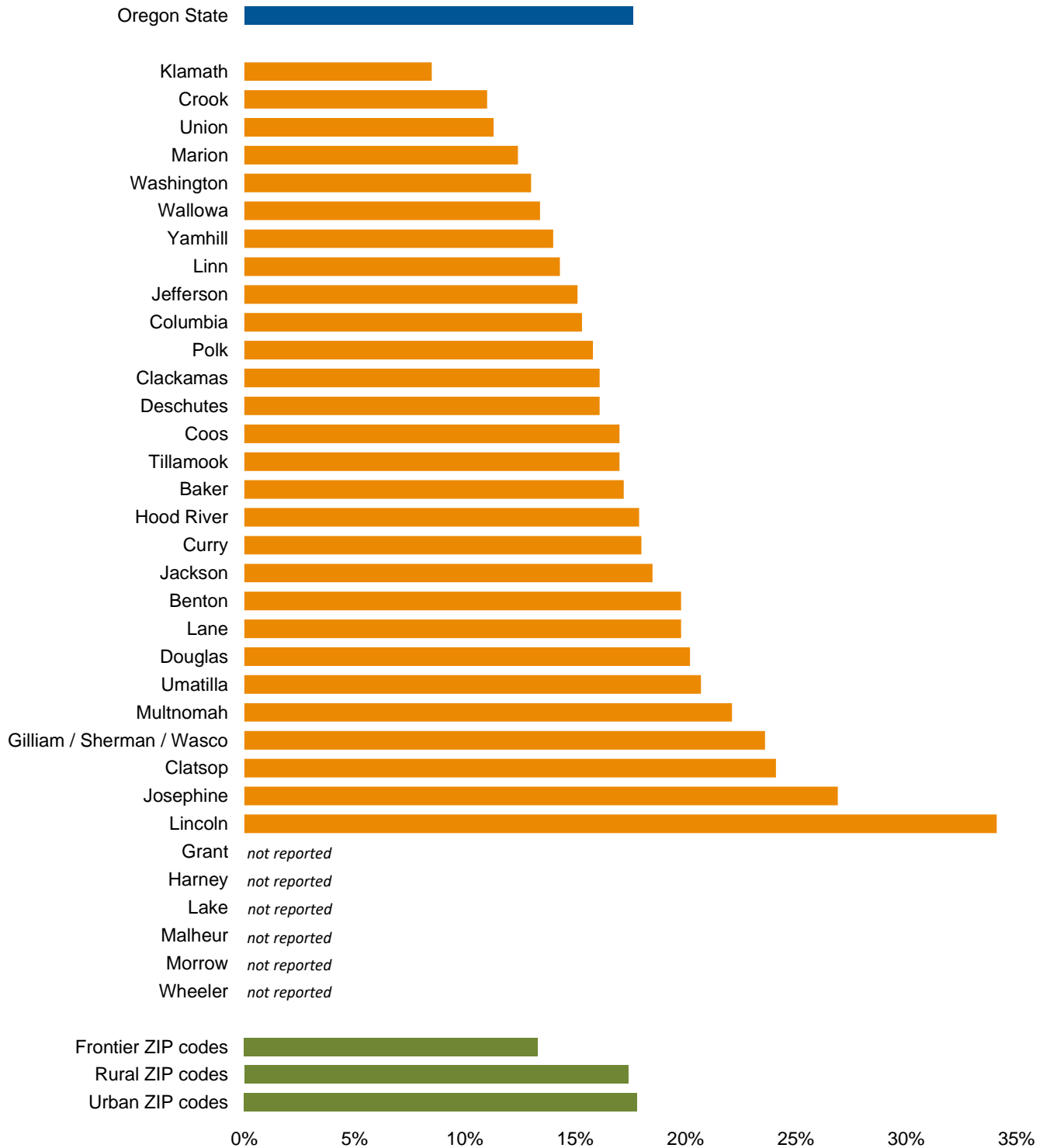


Current marijuana use among adults by county, Oregon, 2014–2017

Includes respondents who report using marijuana or hashish (grass, hash or pot) on at least 1 occasion in the past 30 days.
