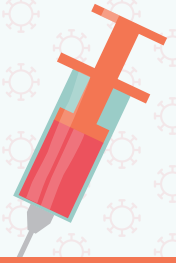




# COVID-19 Vaccine Eligibility

FOR OREGONIANS LIVING WITH HIV



In Oregon, all people living with HIV are eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine this spring, regardless of their viral load or CD4 count

## WHEN YOU QUALIFY FOR THE VACCINE



**MARCH 29**

HIV+ people  
ages 45 and up



**APRIL 5**

HIV+ people  
ages 16 and up



You may already qualify for the COVID-19 vaccine based on age, job type, residence or another qualifying factor

Some counties may be able to vaccinate you sooner. More information on distribution by county can be found [online](#).

## WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW



You won't be asked to verify your HIV status, nor should you provide this information



You will not be asked to pay for the vaccination



You won't be asked about your immigration status

The vaccine is safe for people with HIV and should be taken when available, regardless of the maker



**95%**

93% effective at  $\geq 14$  days post vaccination in preventing hospitalization and death due to COVID-19
