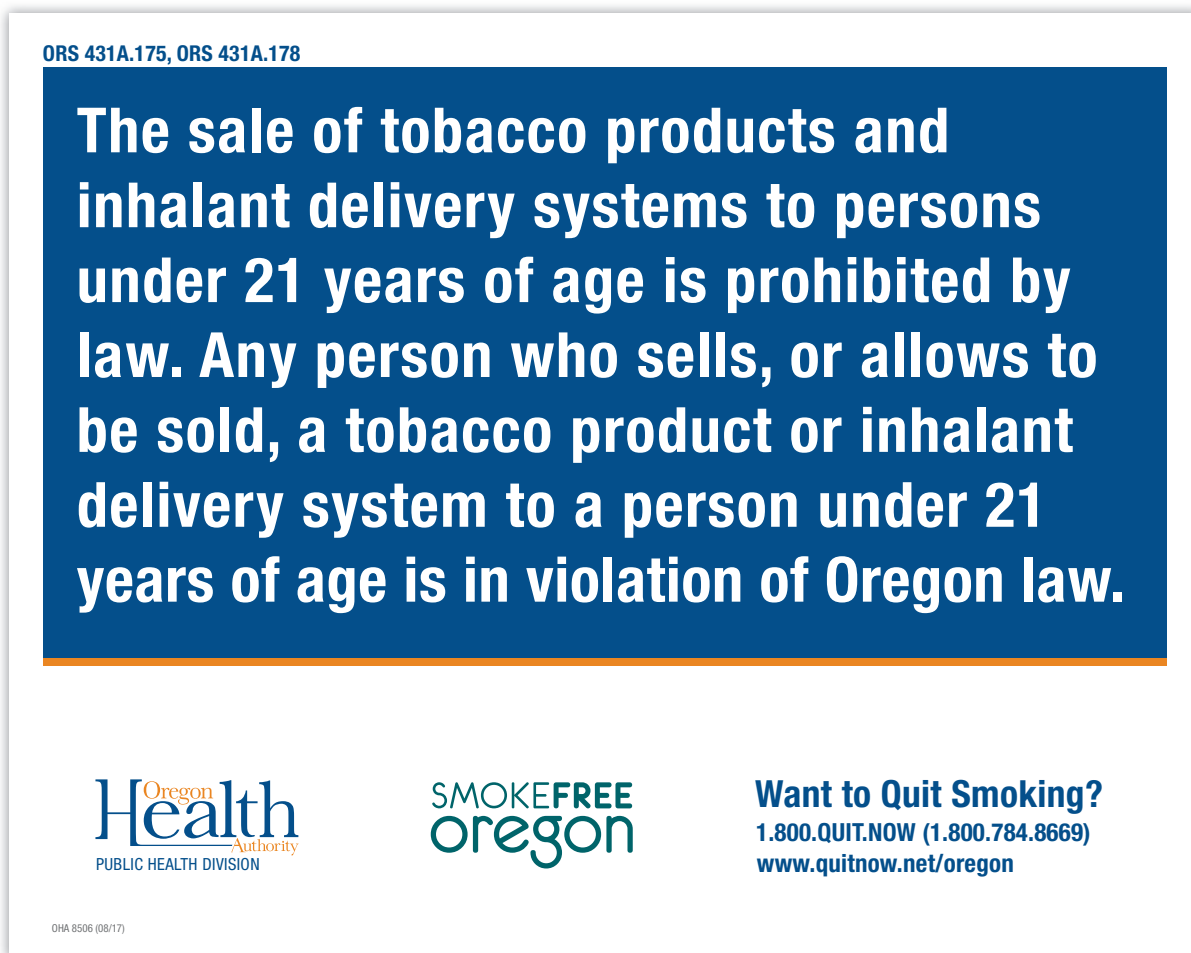


Oregon Tobacco State Notice Sign Law

Did you know that the law requires you to post the state notice sign? A failure to post it (or a notice substantially similar) where it is clearly visible to employees and customers will result in a violation (Oregon Revised Statute 431A.175).

Here is what the sign looks like:
