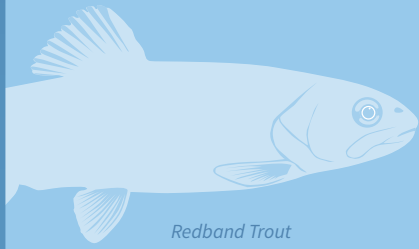

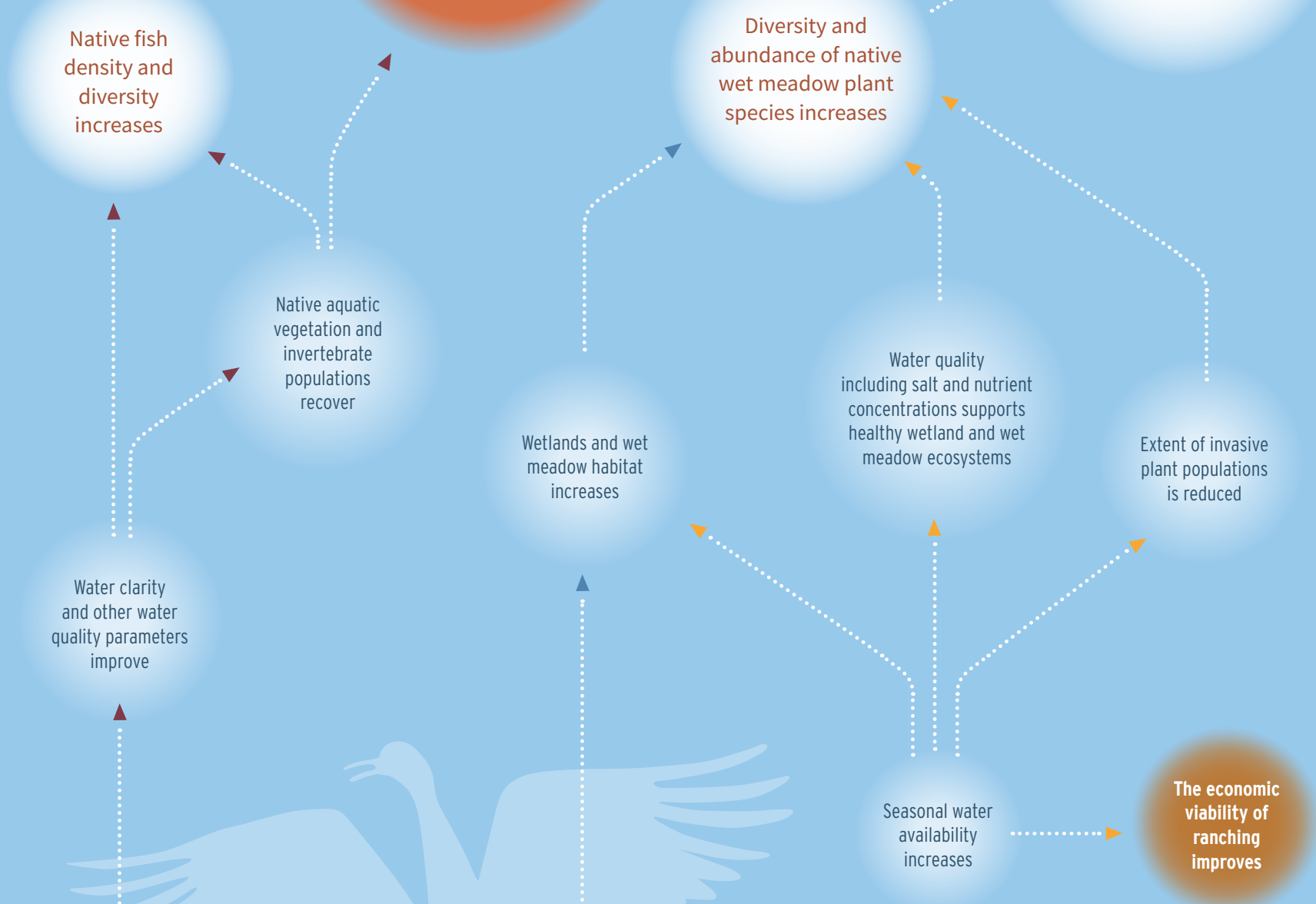

IMPLEMENTATION RESULTS

STRATEGIES



- Carp abundance is reduced
- Carp control measures are evaluated and improved

- Wetland habitats are restored and existing wetlands are managed to support migratory wetland birds
- Wetland restoration and management actions are evaluated and improved

- Flood irrigation practices optimize habitat values for migratory water-bird species and forage production.
- Aging and inefficient diversions and irrigation infrastructure are replaced with efficient flood-irrigation systems

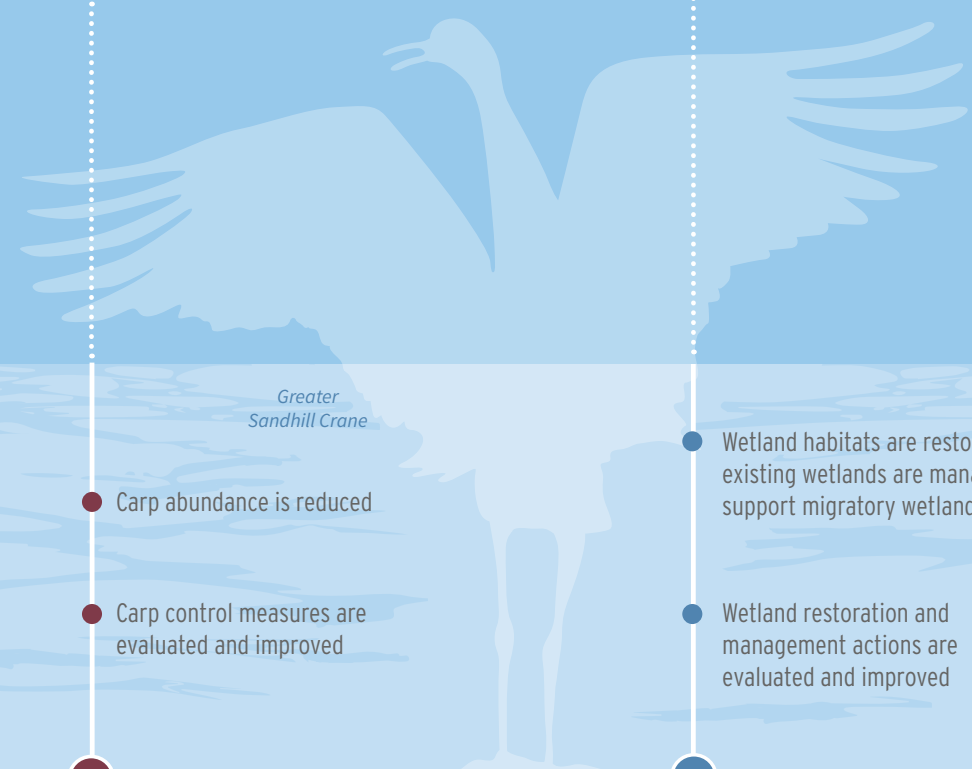
