

# Oregon Certified Public Road Mileage

The table below shows the State of Oregon’s Certified Public Mileage since 1960. The Federal Highway Administration defines a public road as: “Roads under the jurisdiction of and maintained by a public authority which are open to travel by 2 wheel drive passenger vehicles” (paraphrased)<sup>1</sup>.

Significant mileage change reasons:

- 2021, 2017 BLM increases public miles reported
- 2013 BLM begins reporting public miles again
- 2007 drop in Oregon State Forest and USFS reported miles
- 1998 BLM miles no longer considered public by Federal rule
- 1994 BLM reported fewer miles
- 1985 USFS closed many miles to the public
