4. Budget Review

Ian: Funding available, a little short to fund everything, \$48k short, carry over from COVID-19. Confident by June/July we will have enough money to fund all applications. Fund on a ranking 1-12, make recommendation to fund others as funds become available. Ending balance, this biennium: \$15M. Need to keep 1 year of funds in the

bank, so want the ending balance around \$8M. Reasons the ending balance is so large are: more permit, more fuel taxes did not spend everything last year. 20k more ATV Permits sold this year. Last May we had 198,000 active ATV permits in a 2-year time. Fuel taxes have been increasing. Currently at 38 cents a gallon (was .30 cent a gallon before 2017). Had a lot carry over from last year due to supply chain issues. Working on preparing the budget over the next few months. Thoughts, looking at investing in riding areas, staging areas, toilets and other improvements. Need to be thinking about the inflation we are seeing. Last grant cycle we funded a lot of equipment, such as ATVs, side-by-side and trail equipment (dozers, excavators and skid steers) for programs Barrett: Speak to the revenue side, try to match the increasing cost. Surplus funds that are backed up and need to be deployed. Strategic investments to get rid of that backup surplus money.
